Robert “Bob” Spoerry, 67, of LHC lost his life on August 11, 2014 at his family home. He was born August 8, 1947 in Colfax, Iowa. His parents, Robert and Gretchen Spoerry, moved him and his brother John to Phoenix in 1957. Bob enlisted in the Army and served from 1968 to 1971 as a Sargent in the 8th Special Forces Group. Upon leaving the military, Bob began his career in law enforcement that saw him serve 12 years in Phoenix and 20 years in Lake Havasu City. He was a decorated police officer and detective who had a positive impact on the community throughout his years of service. Bob was a long time member of the FOP and the Moose Lodge.

He was an extremely active parent, coaching all four of his children in various sports throughout their lives. He enjoyed golf, cruising his Harley, and traveling to see friends and family.

Bob was preceded in death by his brother, John, and his father Robert. He is survived by his mother, Gretchen; daughters Stephanie Spoerry and Natalie (Michael) Davis; sons Raymond Fraser and Kyle Fraser; grandsons Tristan Tunstall and Isaiah Davis.
